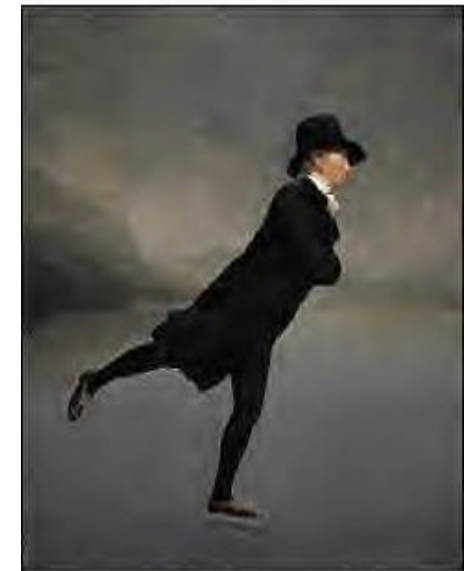

Art is what we do to show that we are more than just animal; to show that we know who and what we are.

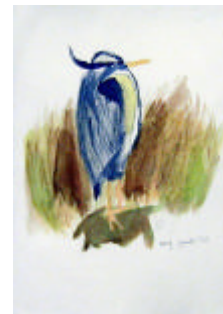
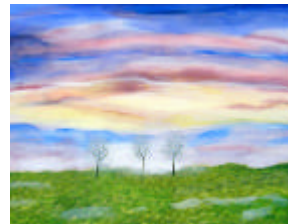
